Expedition Seeks Whalewatchers

Do whales swim in their sleep? Do they drink water or just live in it? Can oversized mammals like these be undernourished?

Operation Whalewatch is looking for whalewatchers to find the answers to questions like these. "We want skippers, scientists, crewmen — anyone who wants to know more about whales," said Clark Cameron, organizer of the operation. "We also need sailing craft in the 25 foot and over category."

Dr. Floyd Durham of USC will direct the expedition. Dan Lindquist and Scott Bailey will be involved in organizing the observation of the whale pods.

An estimated dozen boats will set sail on Friday, Nov. 10, moving toward picket positions from Catalina Island northwest toward Santa Barbara Island. Early Saturday the Come-Fly-With-Me club will send a seaplane to begin a search pattern for whale pods or individual whales. Yachts nearest the whales will be directed by the airborne observers.

The same procedure will take place on Sunday.

According to Professor Theodore Walker, a whale specialist at Scripps Institute of Oceanography in La Jolla, the longest continuous period of human observation of whales in their natural environment is only eight hours. Operation Whalewatch hopes to exceed this period during the two-day watch, followed by continuous observations over a four-month period.

"In addition to whalewatching at sea, we've organized a systematic observation of captive mammals at Marineland, courtesy of curator John Prescott and his staff," said Cameron.

Interested whalewatchers or skippers of seaworthy sailboats are invited to join Operation Whalewatch. Further details may be had from Clark Cameron at 451-0777.

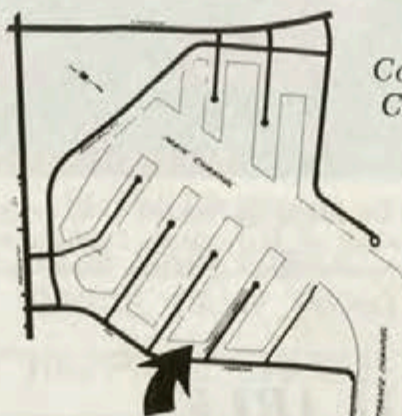

IN CLOVER WITH THE CLOVE HITCH

You can easily fill most knotical kneads around your boat with the clove hitch and its close cousins. The familiar, basic clove hitch—or "cloven hitch," if you are a purist—is used for making a temporary tie over a piling or post.



BASIC CLOVE HITCH

The accepted way to make fast to a cleat is merely an elongated clove hitch. For a better purchase, you don't have to go to Alpha Beta—just take a turn or two around the cleat first, clockwise if practical.

CLOVE HITCH ON A CLEAT



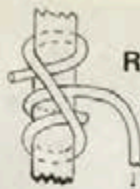
For tying to a post more securely than with a basic clove hitch, pass the line around the post and put a clove hitch on the line itself (the "standing part")—and you have two half hitches. This knot is useful for hanging fenders on stanchions or hitching to an eye.



TWO HALF HITCHES

To pull lengthwise on a spar or line—for example, to make slack in a taut line to relieve a winch overrun—clap on a rolling hitch. It is simply a clove

hitch with an extra turn in the end you are going to haul on.



ROLLING HITCH

For a quick, temporary whipping to keep the end of a line from fraying, use an Ashley constrictor knot—a clove hitch with one end turned under the other.



ASHLEY CONSTRICTOR KNOT

On all of these knots, the turns are to be brought up close together and the ends drawn tight. There are quick ways to make most of them and ways to tie all of these knots so they can be quickly untied. If enough readers indicate interest, Boatin' will make more trips into Marlinespike Bay to look at them.

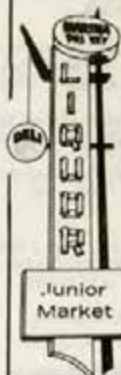
